## Notice of Student Rights

1. You may cancel your contract for educational services with this school without any penalty or obligation the fifth business day following your first class session as described in the Notice of Cancellation form that will be given to you at the first class you attend. A different cancellation policy for home study or correspondence courses. Read the Notice of Cancellation form for an explanation of your cancellation rights and responsibilities. If you have lost your Notice of Cancellation form, ask the school for another copy.
2. After the end of the cancellation period, you have a right to terminate your studies at this school at any time, and you have the right to receive a refund for the part of the course not taken. Your refund rights are described in the contract. If you have lost your contract, ask the school for a description of the refund policy.
